LEGAL NOTICE NO. 89

THE REGISTRATION OF BUSINESS NAMES ACT

(Cap. 499)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Registration of Business Names Act, the Attorney-General makes the following Rules –

THE REGISTRATION OF BUSINESS NAMES (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2003

1. These Rules may be cited as the Registration of Business Names (Amendment) Rules, 2003.
2. The Registration of Business Names Rules are amended by deleting rule 10 and substituting therefor with the following new rule –

	Kshs.
(a) on enquiring whether the proposed name may be registered	100
(b) on lodging a statement of particulars if required under the Act	600
(c) on lodging a notice of change	600
(d) for the issue of a fresh certificate under section 14(2)	200
(e) for inspecting the register in respect of any one business name	200
(f) for a certified copy of or an extract from any filed document	100
(g) on application to lodge a statement of particulars or a notice of change out of time-	
(i) for the first month or part thereof during which the default continues	200
(ii) for every subsequent month during which the default continues (up to a maximum of shs.400)	100
(h) for lodging a notice of cessation of business	200
(i) for the issue of a certificate of registration	200
